

Bicycle/Equipment Rules

After hearing from many riders and seeking input from other series organizers we determined that BC Interior Cyclocross should implement minor equipment rules for 2014.

Overwhelmingly we received concerns that mountain bikes and flat bar bikes are not only an unfair advantage but are sometimes dangerous on many sections of various BC Interior Cyclocross Series race courses. Their ability to corner and brake faster than almost all cross bikes makes them a liability now that we have larger numbers of racers on course.

Elite (Formerly A group):

- Handlebar: Drop or Moustache Bar (Bar with two bends with one bend greater than 25 Deg.)
- Must have STI type or Single-speed Road Levers (*Strict*)
- No suspension equipped bicycles. (*Strict*)
- Wheel Size: 700c at the rim (*Strict*)
- Tire Size: Max 35c (*Honour System*)

Sport (Top riders from 2013 B Group and Bottom Riders from 2013 A Group):

- Handlebar: Drop or Moustache Bar (Bar with two bends with one bend greater than 25 Deg.)
- Must have STI type or Single-speed Road Levers (*Strict*)
- No suspension equipped bicycles. (*Strict*)
- Wheel Size: 700c at the rim (*Strict*)
- Tire Size: Max 35c (*Honour System*)

Open (Formerly B Group):

- Handlebar: Drop or Moustache or MTB Handle Bar
- Tire Size: No Limits
- Wheel Size: No Limits
